After I allowed you to install the Hexagonal sight on my Colt .45 Auto, and I seldom let anyone handle my weapon, I was immensely pleased with the extremely fine workmanship. It was the cleanest job I have ever seen.

I followed your advice and endeavored to change my ingrained mind-set with regard to target acquisition. I fired perhaps 1,000 rounds of dry-fire. I shot everything in sight: dogs, cats, aircraft, ground squirrels, both near and far, with both eyes open as suggested.

To my utter amazement, everything fell into place so quickly I couldn't believe it. I still don't, but it works. For me this sight opens up a totally new adventure in shooting.

I found this out by going to a range and putting all my previous practice into effect. I hit everything I shot the first time around. What is amazing is that everything is automatic. You look, identify, shoot and hit.
