I want to let you know how much I enjoyed your class in Stockton, California on Saturday, September 23, 2006, and Sunday, September 24, 2006. I apologize for having to leave early on Sunday, but, duty calls and I had to get back to take care of business.

I found the classroom portion to be very informative; the sight system, the design and the procedure used to use the sight. Teaching an old dog new tricks is not always an easy task. I went into the class with an open mind and attempted to maintain an open mind throughout the training. I found that your explanation of the sight design and suggested sighting method with your particular sight system to be very sound. I am a veteran Law Enforcement Officer of thirty-eight years and have been teaching firearms the majority of that time to other law enforcement officers and academy cadets. To say the least, old habits die hard, but again I have maintained an open mind toward the HexSite sighting system. I am very happy to report that I have grown in a very short time to like the HexSite system very much and my shooting skill with this sighting system continues to improve.

I went out to our range this past week and qualified with the Glock 23, the one you worked on and put the HexSite system on. My shot grouping was much better than it ever has been at 25 yards. I fired my standard Glock Mod. 22 with Trijicon night sights and my shot grouping didn't even come close to what I shot with the HexSite system.

I am truly excited about your HexSite system and intend to continue working very diligently with it. I have also introduced it to my range masters and will be working with them to get their input and feedback on the HexSite system. The toughest part is retraining the older shooters to look at the target and not the sights, after looking at the sights for so many years. The bottom line is very simple in my estimation, your sight

system works and works very well, I intend to work with the HexSite system and finely hone my shooting skills with it to the point that I have mastered the HexSite system.


